### **PMCK DELIVERS RESILIENT PROFITS ON STEADY DEMAND FOR PRIVATE HEALTHCARE SERVICES**

Alor Setar, 16 March 2026 - Private healthcare services provider PMCK Berhad (“PMCK” or the “Group”, Bursa: 0363) (“PMCK有限公司”) reported a net profit of RM3.81 million for the third quarter ended 31 January 2026 (“3QFY26”) on revenue of RM22.70 million, translating to earnings per share (“EPS”) of 0.36 sen.

The Group recorded gross profit of RM7.37 million during the quarter, representing a gross profit margin of 32.45%.

Healthcare support services contributed approximately 70.53% of the Group’s revenue in 3QFY26. By type of patient care, inpatient services remained the primary revenue driver, accounting for 80.15% of total revenue for 3QFY26.

For the cumulative nine months ended 31 January 2026 (“9MFY26”), PMCK recorded revenue of RM69.88 million. Healthcare support services continued to be the main contributor to the Group’s revenue, while inpatient care remained the primary driver of patient care revenue.

During the period, the Group incurred one-off listing expenses of RM2.67 million, which were offset by a net gain on reversal of impairment of financial assets totalling RM6.06 million following the full settlement received in relation to previously undelivered COVID-19 vaccines.

As a result, the Group recorded a net profit of RM10.41 million, translating to earnings per share of 0.97 sen.

Gross profit for the nine-month period stood at RM24.44 million, representing a gross profit margin of 34.97%.

As at 31 January 2026, the Group remained in a strong financial position with cash and bank balances of RM23.72 million, alongside fixed deposits of RM10.98 million and short-term investments amounting to RM58.67 million.

Total equity stood at RM157.57 million, while net assets per share attributable to owners of the Company stood at RM0.14.

Managing Director Dato' Lee Gaik Cheng (拿督李伊卿) said the Group's performance reflects resilient demand for private healthcare services and stable patient flows across its core specialties.

"We are encouraged by the steady demand for our healthcare services and remain focused on strengthening our service capabilities through the recruitment of additional specialists and ongoing enhancements to our medical equipment and facilities."

She added that PMCK Group is also advancing its digital transformation initiatives to enhance operational efficiency and patient experience.

"We are continuing to enhance our electronic hospital information system, patient-centred digital appointment platforms and administrative workflow automation to improve productivity and support long-term operational resilience."

Looking ahead, PMCK remains cautiously optimistic, supported by sustained demand for private healthcare services.

Notwithstanding the conclusion of the Hospital Services Outsourcing Programme ('HSOP') in December 2025, the Group remains open to re-engaging with HSOP or similar public-private initiatives should such opportunities arise. In preparation, PMCK is upgrading selected medical equipment and enhancing clinical capabilities to support potential collaboration programmes.

At the industry level, the Ministry of Health's ongoing data collection for the proposed diagnosis-related group ("DRG") framework reflects continued efforts to enhance cost transparency and standardisation within the healthcare ecosystem. The Group will continue to monitor developments and assess the potential implications as more details emerge.

Aligned with its long-term strategy, PMCK will also continue to evaluate selective merger and acquisition opportunities that complement its existing operations, subject to strategic fit and financial discipline.

Supported by steady healthcare demand, ongoing service enhancements and disciplined cost management, the Group believes it is well positioned to pursue sustainable growth within Malaysia's evolving private healthcare landscape.
